Think Tank studies DTC in detail

MUMBAI: Global taxation experts and members of a specially convened Global Think Tank have recommended a window of four months to further analyze and submit detailed recommendations on the Direct Tax Code Bill to the Government of India. A request for this extension has been made to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Finance by Nishith Desai, Founder, Nishith Desai Associates and Convener of the Global Think Tank. The members of the Global Think Tank include renowned academicians, jurists, public policy experts and industry leaders from developed and developing countries, some of who have been actively involved in the tax enforcement and reform processes in their respective countries.
